Assists families in securing safe housing and stable employment

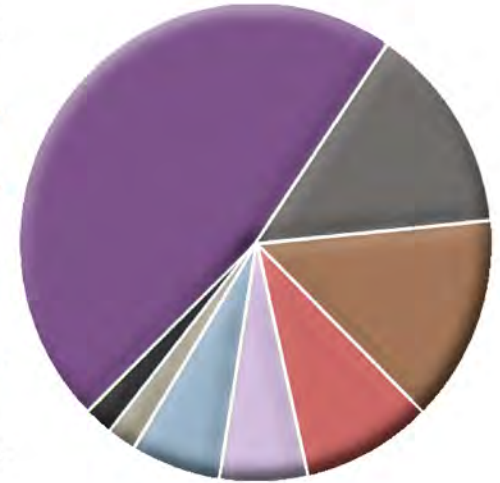

Short-term case management and emergency financial assistance to increase victim safety and offender accountability

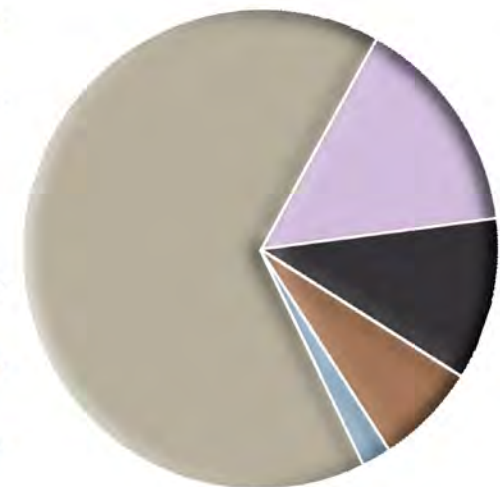
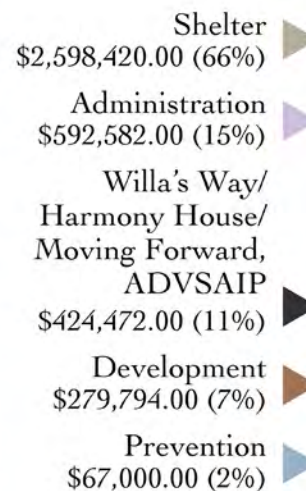

Income



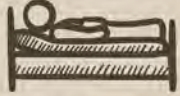

203 days over capacity in shelter (55% of the year)

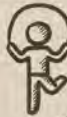
308 individuals receiving legal advocacy
