Many abused women who are moving out on their own have to start with almost nothing. They need virtually everything an empty apartment lacks: cleaning products, paper products, towels, small pots & pans, utensils and more. You or your organization can create a Starter Kit for a woman who is establishing her own place.

What is a Starter Kit?

A Starter Kit can be whatever you come up with!

Fill a plastic tub with the kinds of household items any person would need as they moved into a new apartment. The tub can be large or small, and should have a lid that closes. The tub can be used later for storage - that's part of the gift!

Use your imagination to fill a tub!

Ideas include:

Paper towels, a flash light, dish detergent, screwdriver, hammer, laundry detergent, light bulbs, bar soap, sponges, scrub brushes, small sauce pan, frying pan, can opener, plastic drinking glasses, pot holders, towels, wash cloths

Please avoid breakable or perishable items.
